- 1. Meet all of the deadlines to avoid stress; do not leave things until the last minute!
- 2. Back up your work on a memory stick and your computer in case you lose it.
- 3. Start revising for the exam early; it's a big mistake to leave it until the last minute.
- 4. Print off the mark schemes for coursework and exams so that you understand how marks are allocated.
- 5. Make sure you fully understand the assessment objectives before you start writing coursework and revising for the exams so that you don't waste any time.
- 6. Work really hard in lessons, otherwise you end up having to do **A LOT** of work at home.
- 7. Keep an appendix of the books and websites you use in your coursework; you will forget where you found your information!
- 8. Complete as many exam questions as possible, making sure that you use the scenarios correctly.
- 9. Print off the mark schemes and examiners reports for the previous exam sessions, to see what the examiners are expecting and what the common mistakes students make are.
- 10. Always ask your teacher if you are unsure of anything.
