# What will you study?

- Health and Social Care (Level 3 Cambridge Technical Extended Certificate)\*
- A Level Sociology
- Your choice of <u>one</u> of the following A Level subjects:
  - English Language
  - Business
  - Politics
  - Information Technology (Level 3 National Extended Certificate)\*
  - Criminology Diploma

# GCSE requirements:

Students wishing to pursue this programme must have achieved 4 x standard GCSE passes (grade 4-9), PLUS 2 x strong passes (grade 5 or higher), which <u>must</u> include:

### English Language – grade 4

Double Science (Core <u>and</u> Additional) – grade 4 in BOTH, <u>or</u> a grade 4 in two separate Sciences Maths – grade 4 (for students opting for either Psychology or Business)

\*Applied General Qualifications are rigorous, advanced (Level 3) qualifications. They allow entry to a range of higher education courses, either by meeting the entry requirements in their own right or being accepted alongside, and adding value to, other qualifications at Level 3, such as A Levels. They include a 40% exam requirement.
