

THIS WEEK'S BIG READ: CIRCADIAN RHYTHMS

A circadian rhythm is a natural internal process that all living things cycle through approximately every 24 hours. This cycle helps organisms to adapt, survive, and thrive.

Circadian rhythms are central to our "internal clock", which makes sure we are awake and asleep when we need to be, based on our environment. Things like jet lag, night shifts, and conditions such as insomnia can disrupt these rhythms, which is why a regular sleep routine is important.

There's been a huge increase in animal neglect and abandonment in England and Wales and the RSPCA's rescue centres are "absolutely full". The charity blames lockdown, the cost of living crisis and winter for rising animal abandonment and neglect.



NO STONE LEFT UNTURNED

Archaeologists are recovering Stone Age artefacts from the bottom of the North Sea. Using special equipment, scientists have just brought 100 flint artefacts made by Stone Age humans to the surface. The sites are 12-15 miles off the Norfolk coast.



A FAKE DISPLAY

Thousands of people gathered in the centre of Birmingham on New Year's Eve to watch a fireworks display that they had heard about on social media. Police warned that no display was taking place, but lots of people gathered at midnight.



THEATRES UNDER PRESSURE

Hundreds of theatres face closure and more than 500 museums have shut in recent years. There are currently around 1,110 theatres across the UK. A report suggested that one in five venues needs at least £5m over the next 10 years to stay open.
